YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED TO ACTIVE DUTY FOR THIS PURPOSE AND WILL BE CONSIDERED IN AN ACTIVE DUTY STATUS DURING THE TIME REQUIRED FOR PHYSICAL EXAMINATION AND FOR TRAVEL NECESSARY FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THESE ORDERS.

2. IF FOUND NOT PHYSICALLY QUALIFIED, YOU WILL IMMEDIATELY RETURN TO YOUR HOME AND UPON ARRIVAL CONSIDER YOURSELF RELEASED FROM ACTIVE DUTY. IN THIS EVENT THE EXAMINING MEDICAL OFFICER WILL ADVISE THE BUREAU OF NAVIGATION BY DISPATCH, STATING THE DEFECTS TOGETHER WITH HIS RECOMMENDATIONS,

3. If found physically qualified, you will further proceed and report to the Commandant, Third Naval District, New York, New York, on November 24, 1941, for temporary active duty under instruction. Upon completion of the course of instruction, on or about December 19, 1941, when directed by the Commandant, Third Naval District, you will be detached; proceed to San Francisco, California, and report to the Commandant, Twelfth Naval District, on January 8, 1942, for further
