1. Forwarded recommending payment on the basis of the commercial cost of first class rail transportation and authorized pullman accommodations from San Francisco, Calif., last permanent duty station to New York, N. Y.

2. It is noted that dependents traveled at own expense, departing from San Francisco, Calif., June 2, 1942. and arriving at New York, N. Y., June 7, 1942.

3. Government transportation was not available and no transportation was furnished by the government on this change of station.

4. Transportation Requests, N-623,531, N-623,532 and N-623,533, issued for dependents travel from Vallejo, Calif. to New York, N. Y., were returned to the District Disbursing Officer, July 9, 1942 for cancellation.
