POWER OF ATTORNEY

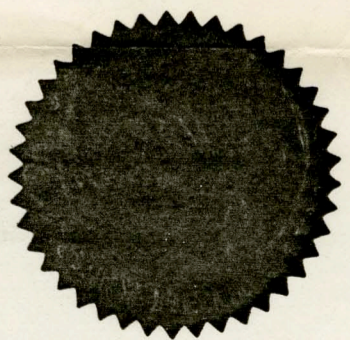
