FOUNDING CHURCH OF SCIENTOLOGY

On May 31, 1977, the Complaint filed in U. S. District Court, Washington, D. C., on January 31, 1977, by plaintiff, Founding Church of Scientology of Washington, Inc., in Civil Action No. 77-0175, was reviewed, and the numerous allegations that the FBI and other named defendants unlawfully collected and disseminated erroneous and derogatory information regarding the plaintiff and its founder, L. Ron Hubbard, were noted.

On May 31 and June 1, 1977, all files of the Honolulu Office of the FBI with indices references to the Founding Church of Scientology of Washington, Inc., and L. Ron Hubbard were reviewed.

The review of these files and the Electronic Surveillance Indices and the Honolulu Mail Cover file failed to disclose that Agents of the Honolulu Office of the FBI ever utilized informants, pretext telephone calls, pretext visits to Scientology locations, warrantless electronic surveillances, mail covers or openings and other unlawful techniques to collect information about the plaintiff organization or its founder, L. Ron Hubbard.

Further, it was determined, after reviewing files of the Honolulu Office containing information pertaining to the plaintiff or its founder, L. Ron Hubbard, that there was
