NOTE: Enclosures consisted of literature of "Allied Scientists of the World," 941 17th Street, Denver, Colorado. The organization claims to be non-ideological, non-denominational and non-racial. It states its goal "the furnishing of maximal protection to the people and culture of various countries against the threat of atomic war." Bureau file 62-95972 reflects the organization as apparently newly formed and unknown to Denver Office until November 30, 1951. The indices of the COMINT Office are negative on this organization and on its officials.
