It states its goal "The furnishing of maximal protection to the people and culture of various countries against the threat of atomic war." Bureau file 62-95972 reflects the organization is apparently newly formed and unknown to Denver Office until November 30, 1951. The indices of the Denver Office are negative on this organization and on its officials.
