SUBJECT: AMERICAN CITIZENS FOR
HONESTY IN GOVERNMENT
MISCELLANEOUS MATTER

On 2/21/79, a group of approximately 50 individuals picketed the Portland Office of the FBI. The protesters carried a variety of placards and distributed fliers (samples attached) urging FBI employees and others to report criminal practices within the FBI to the captioned group. "Freedom", a tabloid newspaper, identified in its masthead as "The Independent Journal Published by the Church of Scientology" February, 1979 issue, was also distributed by the pickets. This newspaper identified the captioned group as a component of the Church of Scientology. The demonstration lasted for approximately one hour during midday and was peaceful and without incident.

During the picketing, a contingent of protesters visited the fourth floor reception area of the FBI Portland Office. They requested both an interview with the SAC and the right to post their literature on the office bulletin board. Both requests were tactfully denied and the group departed without incident or arrest. Media coverage, after the fact, was afforded by local stations.

The above information is being furnished to document contact by supposed members/supporters of the captioned group with the Portland FBI. No investigation has been or will be conducted relative to this matter.

Attached are xerox copies of three fliers distributed by the group and referred to above.

- Expose corruption wherever discovered.
- Uphold these principles, ever conscious that public office is a public trust.

ANY PERSON IN GOVERNMENT SERVICE SHOULD:

Put loyalty to the highest moral principles and to country above loyalty to persons, party, or Government department.

Uphold the Constitution, laws, and legal regulations of the United States and all governments therein and never be a party to their evasion.

Give a full day's labor for a full day's pay; giving to the performance of his duties his earnest effort and best thought.

Seek to find and employ more efficient and economical ways of getting tasks accomplished.

Never discriminate unfairly by the dispensing of special favors or privileges to anyone, whether for remuneration or not; and never accept, for himself or his family, favors or benefits under circumstances which might be construed by reasonable persons as influencing the performance of his governmental duties.

Make no private promises of any kind binding upon the duties of office, since a Government employee has no private word which can be binding on public duty.

Engage in no business with the Government, either directly or indirectly, which is inconsistent with the conscientious performance of his governmental duties as a means for making private profit.

Expose corruption wherever discovered.

Uphold these principles, ever conscious that public office is a public trust.
