The name and address of your counsel, if any, should be promptly forwarded to the Board and counsel should be instructed to communicate immediately with the Recorder of this Board to arrange a convenient date for the hearing of your case.

4. In this connection Enclosure (A) concerning the availability of competent legal counsel, upon your request and free of charge to you as set forth therein, is forwarded for your information and guidance.

5. Due to your present inactive duty status you will not be entitled to reimbursement for any expense incurred in connection with a hearing before this Board.
