MEMORANDUM

To: The President, The Retirement Advisory Board.

1. It appears probable that the press of other duties during the month of December may prevent your attendance at hearings of the Retirement Advisory Board. Accordingly, at your discretion, I desire that you consider that the precept for the Board is temporarily modified to the extent that you may authorize hearings by the Board in your absence or the absence of any member officially absent so long as a majority of the members are present and so long as at least one medical officer is present. This temporary modification of precept is made in the interest of permitting processing of cases without undue delay.
